
From the President's Perspective



Community Outreach



Heart to Heart
CWM
Center for Women's Ministries™

The October Community outreach spotlight is **Heart to Heart Center for Women's Ministries** located in Camden. Heart to Heart is a worldwide organization with 501(c3) status.

They are a group of trained volunteers who provide one-on-one peer counseling services free of charge.

They provide counseling services for women ages 13 and older, providing them a safe place for hope and healing. Women who are grieving, recently divorced, or simply looking for a book study group are all welcome. They offer one-on-one paraprofessional counseling as well as support groups and classes. They believe that God created everyone to be both emotionally and spiritually whole. They truly have a passion for watching Him turn hurt into healing.

Their peer counselors are not professional therapists but do have 50+ hours of training. Therefore, they do recognize that some women need therapy from someone more extensively trained. In these situations, they will make referrals to professional therapists. They will be an advocate along the way to hope and healing.

The Camden location does have a few need requests. They do need volunteers to help as a receptionist maybe just once a month or even once a week. Maybe you want to become a peer counselor. Peer counselors will have to take a 14-week Basic Peer Counseling Course along with a 10-week study, "Making Peace with Your Past."

As far as a monetary need, they do have expenses such as rent, supplies and materials. You can be a one-time donor or choose to donate monthly.

CWM is not affiliated with any one church or denomination. All women are welcome at the Heart to Heart Center in Camden even if you do not have a faith background.
