**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- Scholarship Time Line – according to the SOP, the president will choose participating schools and areas of studies to be the focus of the scholarships. This year Jackie Zimmerman, president, has requested the focus be on Columbia College with no particular area of study to be required. An explanation of her rational for this decision was given. Joanne Engel made a motion to accept and approve the recommendation that the focus for this year's scholarships be Columbia College with no particular area of study required. Holley Smothers seconded. A vote by show of hands was taken and greater than 2/3 approved.
- Publicity of N/L – A discussion regarding the publicity of N/L was had to clarify the intent of the publicity. The intent of the publicity with LO Profile and William Holtz with Lake TV at this time is to make the community aware of the group and the community support it provides. These outlets along with others may be used in the future to promote fundraisers and invite the general public to attend but will be considered on a case by case basis. Events routinely held by N/L are meant for members only. Members may bring a guest one time to an event to allow the guest to see if they want to join. Ladies in the area may attend one event prior to joining to determine if they want to join.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- Registered Agent with the State – Because we are a non-profit group and because we solicit donations for our scholarships, we are required to be registered with the State of Missouri. Paula Constantini gathered and submitted the appropriate paperwork along with the fee to the State of Missouri. The State rejected the submission due to a technicality and sent that information to a past president who was listed as the registered agent. This individual contacted Jackie and requested her name be removed as the registered agent. Following a conversation with the State of Missouri, the registered agent was changed and is now listed as Jackie Zimmerman and we are in good standing until December of 2027. The registered agent can be changed with each renewal if necessary. Jackie stated she is willing to remain as the registered agent so long as she remains active with the organization.

A motion to adjourn the December board meeting was made by Holley Smothers, seconded by Tracy Siegel, and approved. The meeting adjourned at 11:15 am.
