S'more Cupcakes

1 Betty Crocker Super Moist **Milk Chocolate** Cake Mix. Follow directions on the package for cupcakes



Chocolate Buttercream Icing

1/2 cup Butter or margarine
1/2 cup Solid vegetable shortening
1 tsp Vanilla
4 cups Confectioners' sugar
3/4 cup Cocoa powder
2 tbsp heavy cream
1 jar (7oz) Marshmallow Crème

Beat together butter, vegetable shortening, and vanilla.

Slowly mix in cocoa powder and powdered sugar.

Add heavy cream one teaspoon at a time to make desired spreading consistency or a bit stiffer if you are going to use a pipping bag.

Fold in Marshmallow cream.

Frost cupcakes and add toppings.

Top with: Teddy Grahams, Mini Marshmallows, Hershey Bar, & Graham Cracker Crumbs

February Luncheon

Banana Cream Cupcakes with Cream Cheese Icing

Ingredients:

- 4 large eggs, separated
- 1 stick of butter
- 1 t. vanilla extract or ½ t. vanilla/ ½ t. banana extract
- 1 ½ c. mashed very ripe bananas (4 bananas)
- ½ t. baking soda
- 2 t. baking powder
- ¾ c. sugar
- 1 ½ c. flour all-purpose

Icing Ingredients:

- 8 oz. cream cheese (room temperature)
- 4 oz. butter (room temperature)
- 1 t. banana extract
- 4 c. powdered sugar

Cupcake Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Line 24 count cupcake pan with paper liners

Cream butter with electric mixer on medium until fluffy

Add egg yolks, one at a time, mixing after each addition

Add bananas & extract, mix well

Whip egg whites until stiff peaks form

Fold ½ of whipped egg whites into wet mixture

Combine dry ingredients in a separate bowl

Add dry ingredients to wet ingredients & mix until blended

Add remaining 1/2 whipped egg whites & fold in

Bake for 12 minutes

Icing Instructions:

Beat cream until light & fluffy

Beat in butter & extract

Add powdered sugar, mix thoroughly

Pipe icing on tops of each cupcake. I use Wilton #1M


Book Glubs
