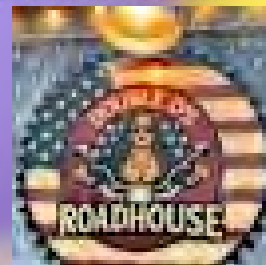

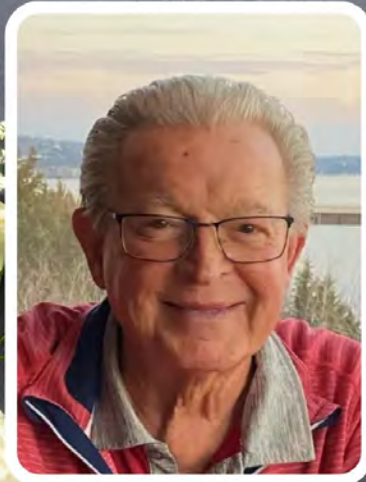
Everybody Buncos Is Moving!
